

The U.S. Department of Education (ED) relies on accrediting agencies (accreditors) to oversee higher education quality. Only institutions and programs accredited by a federally recognized accreditor can provide students with access to federal student aid, including Pell Grants and student loans. Periodically, a subset of the more than 60 federally recognized accreditors come up for review by ED and the National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity (NACIQI).
